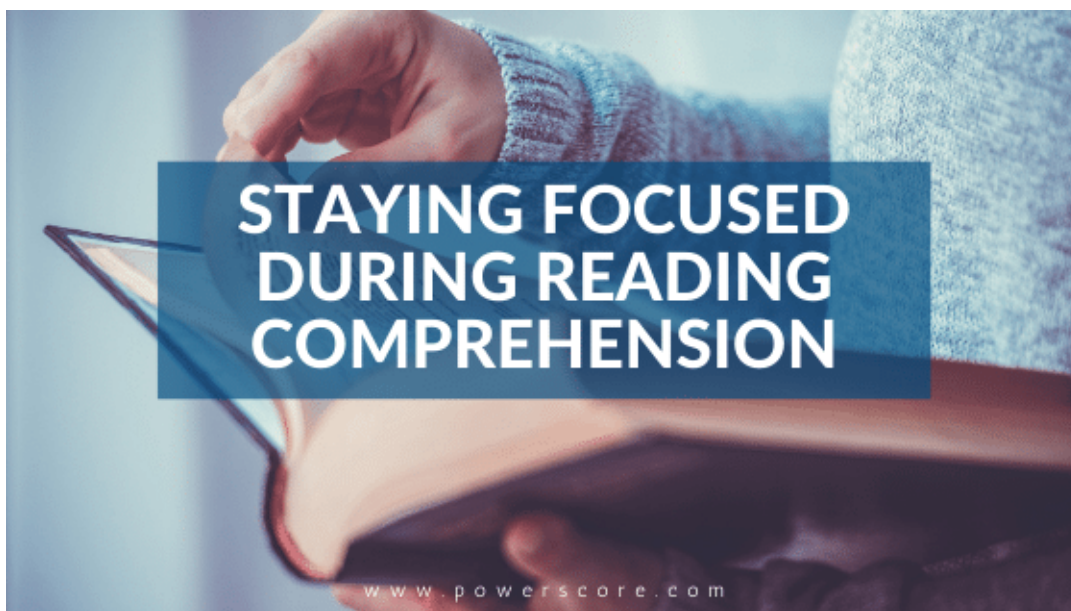


Staying Focused During Reading Comprehension
